Dear Palisades Families,

We anticipate that children, ages 5-11 will be able to receive a COVID (Pfizer) vaccine in early November when approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Assuming that approval is granted, we are considering the scheduling of another vaccination clinic for children and adults in our community like we did last spring and summer. Children (ages 5 & up) would be able to receive the Pfizer vaccine, and our provider, AMI would also have the Moderna and J&J vaccines available for those who wish to receive a first-time or booster vaccine.

In order to gauge interest in scheduling a vaccine clinic at Palisades for our students 5 and older, please take a moment to answer the questions on the attached (below) survey. Clinic dates will be scheduled with AMI based on your interest and preference for in school, after school and/or a Saturday clinic. If you are interested in a Palisades based vaccine clinic, please complete this survey by Friday, October 29th.

In the event there is sufficient interest to schedule vaccine clinics, future communications will include additional information about the vaccines, clinic times and dates and parent permission forms.
