Dear Palisades Families,

Prior to addressing today's COVID notifications, I wanted to advise that if any members of your household receive notification that they have tested positive for COVID, any children in the same household that attend Palisades schools must be kept home pending specific direction from the Bucks County Department of Health. We will work with you to provide learning opportunities through the duration of your child(ren)'s quarantine. Please contact the principal of your child(ren)'s school to discuss remote learning.

COVID Notification:

Since our last notification on Friday, the Palisades School District received notices that a student from Palisades Middle School and an unassigned employee both tested positive for COVID-19.

The district, in collaboration with the Bucks County Department of Health, has completed contact tracing and close contacts, if any, have been contacted. A close contact is defined as a person who was within six feet for 15 minutes or more of a positive case.

Our schools are not closing for in-person or online instruction due to these positive cases.

Please continue to monitor symptoms of your child(ren) and seek guidance from your healthcare provider if symptoms emerge. As always, if your child is sick, please keep him/her at home.
