Using key words *college persistence* in Google Scholar renders myriad studies and articles that speak to gender, ethnicity, race, socioeconomic background, etc.

According to this <u>U.S. News & World Report</u>, "In many cases, 1 in 3 first-year students or more won't make it back for sophomore year."


Common findings that lead to **college persistence** (the return of a student from first year to sophomore year) are <u>relationships</u> and <u>academic preparation</u>.

The Class of 2018 (the most recent data provided) realized a **92%** persistence rate.

Advanced Placement (2020)

<u>Spring 2020 exams</u> were 45-minute, web-based, generally free response (languages did include a speaking component).

Students and teachers found creative ways to connect virtually to review and to continue learning content in preparation for the exams.







Advanced Placement (2020): By the numbers

- 16 course exams were taken in the Spring of 2020
 - 171 exams in total
- 11 courses realized percentages of students earning a 3 or higher equal to or greater than the PA average.
 - 3 courses realized 100% of students earning a 3 or higher
 - 2-D Art and Design (2 students)
 - French Language/Culture (9 students)
 - US Government/Politics (1 student)
