

PSD COVID RESPONSE 22/23

Scenario	Action
Symptoms of a contagious disease (Ex: Flu, Covid-19, common cold, stomach-bug, or any other infection/virus that might cause a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● When your child has a fever of 100.3 degrees or above he/she should remain at home until they are "fever free" for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications (Tylenol, Motrin, etc.). Please do not use medications containing aspirin and aspirin-like products due to concerns related to <u>Reye's Syndrome</u>. ● If your child has vomiting or diarrhea, whether it is the night before or in the morning, they should also remain at home for the day.
Positive Covid-19 Case with NO symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● According to BCDH, if a person tests positive for COVID, but they are asymptomatic it is recommended that the person remains home for one to two days to ensure they aren't about to become sick (they were pre-symptomatic when they tested). ● Palisades will excuse a student that has tested positive for COVID but remains asymptomatic for up to two days to see if symptoms emerge. ● If your child is out longer due to their Healthcare provider's instructions, please provide a Dr. note upon return to school. ● Upon return to school, the student will not be required to wear a mask, but may choose to if they like. They will not be required to eat meals separately.
Positive Covid-19 Case WITH symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remain at home until they are "fever free" for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications (Tylenol, Motrin, etc.) and improving symptoms ● Refer to your Health Care Provider for their instructions and provide a Dr. note upon return to school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Absences shall be treated as unexcused until the district receives a written excuse explaining the absence, to be submitted within three (3) days of the absence. ○ 4 or more consecutive days absent will be excused with a doctor's note (AR No. 204) ○ A maximum of ten (10) days of cumulative lawful absences verified by parental notification shall be permitted during a school year. All absences beyond ten (10) cumulative days shall require an excuse from a licensed practitioner of the healing arts ● Upon return to school, the student will not be required to wear a mask, but may choose to if they like. They will not be required to eat meals separately.
Exposure to Positive Case	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No exclusion Required. ● Testing of asymptomatic individuals is not recommended by BCDH
