- 4. Recommended revision December 16, 2020






Recommended revisions are based on:

PALISADES school district


- Meeting with Pandemic Crisis Response Team on December 8, 2020
- Clarification on transportation of public and non-public students
- Updates by both CDC and PA DOH on face coverings
- Changes to COVID dashboard
- Updated employee screener based on travel restrictions





#### **Revisions:**

All transportation protocols 1. will apply to students taking district transportation to non-public school. Added language including: mask wearing, notification of positive cases, quarantine/isolation status and proof of release from quarantine/isolation prior to accessing transportation. (section 2I, page 18)





Recommendation 2 - discontinue use of face shields as sole form of face covering

**PA DOH** (updated November 17, 2020): *Does a disposable face shield suffice in lieu of a mask?* Wearing a cloth face covering is best. A disposable face shield is considered an alternative to a face covering and may be worn when wearing a face covering is otherwise not possible. <u>https://www.health.pa.gov/topics/disease/coronavirus/Pages/Guidance/Universal-Masking-FAQ.aspx</u>

**CDC** (updated December 15, 2020): Issues caution on face shields. Evaluation is ongoing but effectiveness is not known at this time.

**Health and Safety Plan update**: **face shields** worn alone (without a mask) are only permitted with a doctor's note when mask wearing is not possible. (sections 2I, page 19,4B and 4C, pages 28,29, 31)
