Dear Palisades Families,

On Tuesday, November 10th, Palisades School District received notification from the Bucks County Department of Health that a student at Palisades High School tested positive for COVID-19.

The district in collaboration with the Bucks County Department of Health have completed contact tracing and close contacts, if any, have been contacted. A close contact is defined as a person who was within six feet for 15 minutes or more of a positive case.

Palisades High School is not closing for in person instruction due to this positive case.

Please continue to monitor symptoms of your child(ren) and seek guidance from your healthcare provider if symptoms emerge. As always, if your child is sick, please keep him/her at home.

The district dashboard is now updated with this case. We are no longer updating on Fridays with the week's previous cases.
