COVID Notification:

Today, Monday, November 23, 2020, the Palisades School District received notice that a cyber academy (PCA) student from Palisades High School tested positive for COVID-19.

The district, in collaboration with the Bucks County Department of Health, has completed contact tracing and close contacts have been contacted. A close contact is defined as a person who was within six feet for 15 minutes or more of a positive case.

Our schools are not closing for in-person or online instruction due to this positive case.

Please continue to monitor symptoms of your child(ren) and seek guidance from your healthcare provider if symptoms emerge. As always, if your child is sick, please keep him/her at home.
