The Palisades, Pennridge, Quakertown Community School Districts and Upper Bucks County Technical School hereafter known as the “*school districts*,” will receive a combined proposal for providing trash and recycling services on **APRIL 19, 2024 until 9:00AM** prevailing time at Quakertown Community School District Facilities Service Center, 311 South Ninth Street, Quakertown, PA. 18951. All proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked “**Joint School District Trash & Recycling Proposal**”. Proposals received after the time established above will not be considered.

The *school districts* each reserve the right to accept or reject their portion of the proposal which in their judgment, is in the best interest of their School District. The *school districts* further reserve the right to waive irregularities in the proposal documents or submitted proposals where such waiver is, in the *school districts* judgement, in its best interests.

The above-mentioned proposer hereby declares and certifies:

**ONE:** That we have carefully examined all of the proposal documents, including but not limited to the Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Terms and Conditions, Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Schedule, and Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Proposal Form, and Non-Collusion Affidavit, and in accordance with the same, submit this proposal to provide the specified services for the unit prices indicated on the proposal form completed, executed and submitted herewith.

**TWO:** That this proposal is subject to all terms of these RFP documents and specifications and we hereby agree to enter into a written agreement to furnish and deliver the specified services as required in these RFP documents and specifications.

**THREE:** The unit prices quoted herein are exclusive of Federal Excise Tax and Pennsylvania State Sales Tax.

**FOUR:** Enclosed with this proposal is a list of five (5) names and addresses of references the proposer has done business with in the past three (3) years. Also, enclosed with this proposal is: (a) A company profile detailing years in business, incorporation, if incorporated, number of employees and the background and experience of the principal members of the company or organization, and (b) a representation and/or explanation as to whether or not the proposer has ever defaulted on a contract.

**FIVE:** All proposals shall include (typewritten or in ink) the following completed and signed Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Terms and Conditions, Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Proposal Form, Non-Collusion Affidavit, and any other information required or requested as part of the proposal

**SIX:** The proposer shall furnish services in accordance with all the terms, conditions, and provisions of these documents and specifications under the supervision and to the satisfaction and approval of the individual *school districts*. Either the *school districts* or accepted proposer shall have the right to terminate all or part of the services provided in this proposal with thirty (30) days' notice. The notice of termination must be provided to the other party in writing to the address indicated on the Terms and Conditions or to the respective *school districts* Facilities Office. Furthermore, the *school districts* are hereby authorized, in addition to and without in any way limiting any and all other remedies it may have against the proposer or any other party under contract documents or the law, to retain another supplier to fulfill the contract.

**SEVEN:** The unit prices submitted shall include all fuel, equipment, trash collection bins/compactors and labor charges. Surcharges of any type in excess of the trash and recycling unit price(s) and optional container service unit prices are not permitted.

**EIGHT:** The successful proposer shall provide collection bins or compactors of the number, type and size indicated on the Joint School District Trash Disposal and Recycling Schedule at the location specified by the individual school districts. Relocation of any bins as requested by the *school districts* shall be done at no additional cost. The bins/compactors shall be kept in good repair, including operating lids, and remain the property of the successful proposer.

**NINE:** Human Relations Act: The provisions of the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act. Act 222 of October 27, 1955 (P.L. 744) (43 P.S. Section 951, et. seq.) of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania prohibit discrimination because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age, sex, national origin, handicap or disability by employers, employment agencies, labor organizations, contractors and others. The proposer shall agree to comply with the provisions of this Act as amended that is made part of this specification. Your attention is directed to the language of the Commonwealth's nondiscrimination clause in 16 PA. Code 49.101.

**TEN:** The *school districts* are authorized to speak with all persons and references identified herein as well as other representatives of businesses, agencies or school districts with services which the proposer has been involved. All such persons and

references are authorized to speak freely to the *school districts* relative to any such references, matters or other projects, the proposer is hereby releasing all persons, firms and corporations whether named herein or not from any and all liability, actions, suits, claims or demands arising out of the release, exchange or communication of all such information.

**ELEVEN: Insurance:** The successful proposer shall have insurance coverage meeting the following criteria: All insurance companies shall have an A.M. Best’s Financial Strength Rating of A++, A+, A, A-. The limits of liability for the insurance required shall provide coverage for not less than the following amounts or greater where required by laws or regulations:

If the successful proposer has lower underlying coverage than required above, additional coverage to \$1,000,000 may be provided by excess umbrella form. A certificate of insurance must be supplied to each *school district* by the successful proposer. The *school district* shall be named on the certificate of insurance as additional insured.

**TWELVE: Security Clearances:** The successful proposer may be required to submit to the *school districts* for review and approval; the following security clearances before the successful proposer’s employees will be permitted on the *school districts* property: PA. Act 34 of 1958 (State Police check), PA. Act 151 of 1994 (Child Abuse Act), and PA. Act 114 of 2006 (Federal Criminal History Record). The *school districts* reserve the right to reject any employee that has clearances that are unacceptable.

**THIRTEEN:** By submission of their proposal, the proposer agrees to a 30-45 day payment period by the *school districts* depending upon when the invoice is submitted. Each of the participating *school districts* will make individual billing arrangements with the successful proposer.

**FOURTEEN:** Proposal prices are listed as firm and will remain valid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date established for receiving proposals.

**FIFTEEN:** The request for proposals is for three (3) one-year periods beginning on July 1<sup>st</sup>, and ending on June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. **This RFP agreement shall begin on July 1, 2024 and end June 30, 2027**

**SIXTEEN:** All proposers shall submit questions in writing, via email, to Mr. Kelly Harper [KHarper@Pennridge.org](mailto:KHarper@Pennridge.org) ; no later than April 11, 2024 at 5:00pm. Modifications and interpretations of the RFP shall be made by Addendum. Modifications and interpretations of the RFP made in any other manner shall not be binding. All approved addenda shall be posted electronically on each School District website no later than (5) days prior to the proposal submission deadline.

**SEVENTEEN:** The proposer must provide the *school districts* with the name, location and contact information of the landfill and recycling center that the successful proposer will be using.

**EIGHTEEN:** At no time shall the successful proposer mix trash and recycling in the same truck. If this occurs by accident, the affected *school districts* Facilities Director must be notified immediately.

**NINETEEN:** The successful proposer must follow all current federal, state and local environmental regulations, and Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) regulations. The *school districts* are in no way responsible for the safety of the accepted proposer's service operations.

**TWENTY:** The successful proposer is entirely responsible for any damage caused to the *school districts* property in the performance of the services included in this proposal. The successful proposer and any subcontractors agrees to indemnify, defend (include attorney's costs) and hold harmless the *school districts*, school boards and their employees without limitation, from any legal action or environmental cleanup costs resulting from their failure to perform the services or breach of any conditions included in this request for proposal.

**TWENTY FIRST:** Proposers are hereby notified that the use of tobacco or tobacco products is not permitted on any of the *school districts* property by Pennsylvania State Law: (35PA.CON.S.STAT.ANN1223.5) of 2000.

**TWENTY SECOND:** Any additional non-scheduled pickups of trash or recycling will be billed at the indicated unit cost to the respective *school district(s)*.

**TWENTY THIRD:** The Proposer must accept commingled recyclable materials.
