BUCKS COUNTY COVERED BRIDGES: TUESDAY 12/12

Bucks County is one of the birthplaces of covered bridge building in America. During the 19th century, more than 50 covered bridges were connected across Bucks County, not only crossing the Delaware River but linking towns across the county so that goods produced by local mills could be traded. The last original covered bridge was built in 1875, only 12 remain in Bucks County today, and almost all are listed on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). A self-guided driving/biking tour map can be found online for these historic structures. The Knecht's Covered Bridge is a Springfield Township landmark celebrating its 150th birthday this year with a celebration in the works for Spring of 2024! Join us for a lively, informative presentation about this unique collection of cherished, quintessential Bucks timber structures.
