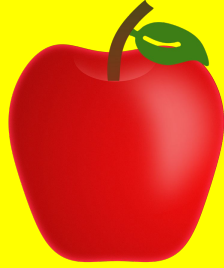

Schedule...explained

- Teachers will hold small group instruction sessions throughout the week (live)

Absence notes can be emailed to the teacher for records.

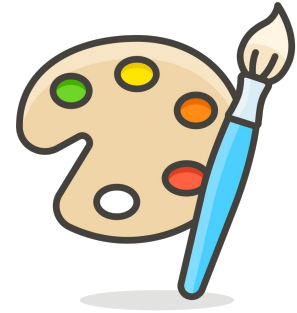
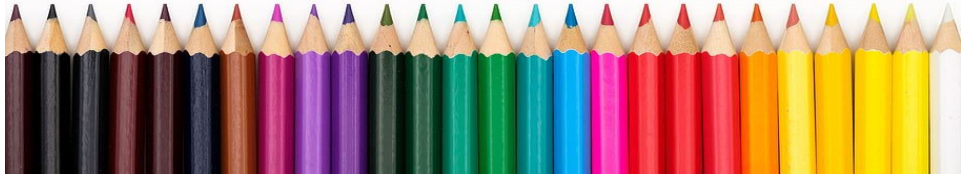
