Youth Mental Health First Aid	<p>Training for those that regularly work with adolescence on how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including AD/HD), and eating disorders.</p> <p>https://www.mentalhealthfirstaid.org/take-a-course/course-types/youth/</p>	\$2,000/instructor (reduced fee applicable \$1850) - as trained trainers	2 trainers = \$3700
Trauma Informed Training	<p>Being trauma informed includes an awareness of the prevalence of trauma, an understanding of the impact of trauma on physical, emotional and mental health as well as on behaviors, and an understanding the current survey systems can retraumatize individuals.</p>	<p>2 groups of 75 (one elementary, one secondary) for a two-hour training for each, one AM, one PM, on the same day (Cost: \$2,500).</p> <p>On a different day, the same participants would participate in Trauma 102 training, again at a cost of \$2,500.</p> <p>For the elementary staff, we would provide NeuroLogic training, a 4 hour program centered on brain basics and intro to trauma, as well as best practices for the trauma informed classroom. The cost is \$4,000 for this training.</p>	\$9,250
