COVID-19 VACCINE FACTS

- Vaccines can help end the pandemic. Getting one will protect your health and prevent disease.
- Vaccines are safe. The U.S. vaccine safety system ensures vaccines are as safe as possible before releasing them to the public.



- Vaccines are effective. Medical studies show the vaccines can prevent COVID-19 and keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get it.
- Masks, hand washing, and distancing are still important. Until enough people are vaccinated, you can protect yourself and others by continuing to wear a mask, washing your hands, and staying 6 feet apart – even if you've had your shots.
